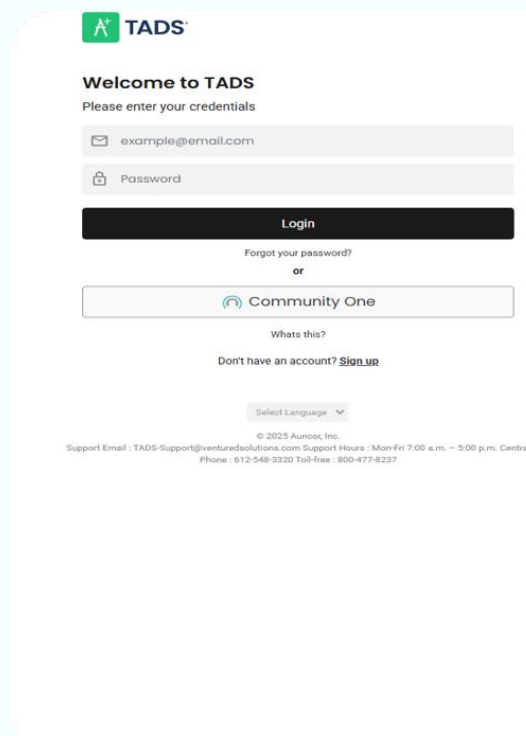

1. Modernized Login Page

Login Page UI Updates


- ✦ Updated appearance to align with other VenturEd products and improve mobile responsiveness.
- ✦ Functional items such as “Forgot Password,” “Change Password,” “Preferred Language,” and MFA authentication remain in place, with visual updates to match the new page design.
- ✦ The new login pages mark the first step in our UI refresh. In the coming months, we will roll out additional updates—starting with the family-facing portals.



2. Release Notes and Product Suggestions Access

Utilizing *Canny* to Enhance Your Product Experience

- ✦ The *Canny* software is now integrated into TADS for School Administrator to use, enabling them to view release notes, explore the public roadmap, suggest new features or changes, and engage with suggestions submitted by other administrators.
- ✦ Links are located in the top right corner of the LBar for administrator use.

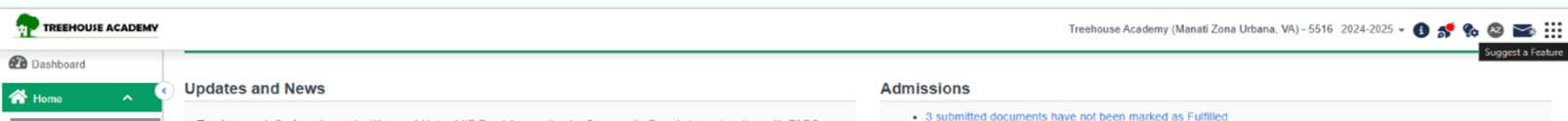

3. Icon Enhancements for Better Visual Cues and Function

Icons Added To LBar

- ✦ Each icon includes hover text that displays its name.
- ✦ The “rocket ship” icon has been added as a link to "New Releases," where public-facing release notes will be posted.
- ✦ The bell icon previously linked to the Knowledge Base has been updated to an (i) information icon.
- ✦ The “lightbulb” icon has been added as a link to Canny’s “Suggest a Feature” function, where administrators can submit new suggestions and review or support existing ones.
- ✦ The “gear” icon for administrator email notification settings has been updated to an envelope with gear, providing a clearer visual cue that these are email-related settings.



4. Updated Group Rules for Charges and Credits on Tuition Agreements

- ❖ Group Ruling enables dynamic recalculation of charges and credits when families access their agreements during Streamlined Enrollment.
- ❖ Questions answered during Enrollment—such as field trip attendance or extracurricular signups—can be associated to groups to automatically apply associated program fees.
- ❖ A setting to allow or block changes from Group Ruling has been added to the "Add Charge" and "Add Credit" pages on agreements. Previously, this option was only available on the "Edit Charge" and "Edit Credit" pages.
- ❖ The wording on the setting has been updated on the "Add Charge," "Add Credit," "Edit Charge," and "Edit Credit" pages to clarify how each option affects group rule calculations.
- ❖ Additional warning text has been added to the setting that allows group-based recalculations, clearly highlighting its importance and how it impacts the amounts families see when setting up their agreement.

5. Updated Group Rules for Charges and Credits on Tuition Agreements (Continued)

- ✦ To ensure accuracy and a smoother experience for families, a hard block has been implemented to prevent users from adding multiple instances of the same charge or credit for a single student on a tuition agreement when group rules are in use. Allowing duplicates in these cases previously caused calculation errors and confusion for families accessing their agreements. This update helps maintain data integrity and improves the overall enrollment experience.
